Mr. Lloyd reported on the pool revenues vs. expenditures. The pool has never made money. Expenditures for 2015 are an excess of \$20,000.00.

(K) Street Committee: Mayor Shane Nickerson reported on Mansfield Borough Sidewalk Grant

Program that started <u>+</u> 25 years ago. Mansfield's yearly Sidewalk Project costs usually \$10,000.00 - \$22,000.00. Matching funds come from local banks, BOOM, and Borough. Eligible sidewalks must run parallel with streets. Applications are simple, which Blossburg could use. Property

owner and Borough pay contractor individually.

(L) Shade Tree Commission: Nothing to report.

(M) Budget:

Total donations received for new lawn mower for Island Park: \$6,533.28. Cost of new zero-turn mower would be approximately \$8,500.00.

Councilmembers discussed purchase of new mower for Island Park. Motion to purchase a zero-turn mower for Island Park was made by Thomas Bogaczyk; second, Paul Hosszu. President James Rakoski opposed.
